Procedure to be followed:

- The POCSO Committee is a mandatory body established in educational institutions to resolve complaints of sexual offences against children under the age of 18.
- It is constituted under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act. 2012.
- The Primary role of the POCSO Committee is to investigate complaints from aggrieved children in a child-friendly manner and create a safe and respectful study environment.
- The POCSO Committee shall comprise a senior lady teacher, two employees members (preferably one lady and one gentleman) and one external member from a non-governmental organisation or a person familiar with issues related to the sexual abuse of children two senior students (preferably one boy and one girl) and a lady parent.
- Inquiry into complaint:
- The POCSO Committee shall inquire into the complaint within twenty-four hours of receiving the complaint under the provisions of the POCSO Act.2012 and the rules thereunder as well as the service rules applicable to the employees, if the offender is an employee of the school.



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- On the completion of the inquiry, the Committee shall provide a report of its findings to the employer with a period of twenty four hours from the date of completion of the inquiry.
- If the Committee concludes that the allegation against the offender has not been proven, it shall recommend to the employer that no action is required in the matter.
- If the committee concludes that the allegation against the employee has been proved, it shall recommend to the employer.
 - i) If the Committee concludes that the allegation against the employee has been proved, it shall recommend to the employer.
 - ii) To take action for sexual abuse as misconduct in accordance with the provisions of the service rules applicable to the employee.
 - iii) Lodge an FIR in the local Police Station against the Offender to take appropriate action under the provision of the POCSO Act.2012.
- The committee should undertake an awareness programme among students & staff about the provisions of the law in various aspects, as outlined in the handbook of the POCSO Act.2012 at the beginning of each session every year.
